An application has been filed to add 60 storeys to the building south of Trinity Square. This is almost **4 times the height of what is currently allowed** in that location by the City of Toronto Official Plan. If approved, this building would essentially put Toronto's Official Plan in the shredder.

It could overwhelm and shadow iconic architecture and public spaces: Old City Hall, Nathan Phillips Square, Trinity Square, and the historic Holy Trinity campus.

Trinity Square, with its fountain, labyrinth and walkways is one of the few peaceful public spaces in the downtown where citizens can seek out sunlight and fresh air during the day. This project would nearly double windspeed in Trinity Square.
